“PHILPOTT STORIES”

August 8th, 2017



Nancy Bell will present “Philpott Stories.” What was under Philpott Lake before it was a lake? Who lived there, and why was the lake created? Using an array of photos and first-person interviews with those who lived in the area more than 50 years ago, Nancy Bell will share the history of Philpott Lake. Her book, *The History of Philpott Lake*, will be available for \$10, with proceeds going to the Dan River Basin Association’s efforts to keep the lake serene and beautiful and open for all to enjoy.

Nancy Bell is a 1982 graduate of Radford University and, in 2012, completed Duke University’s graduate certificate program in Nonprofit Management & Leadership. For her efforts with non-profit organizations, she was named Martinsville’s Citizen of the Year in 2006 and United Way of Henry-Martinsville’s Non-profit Leader of the Year in 2010. Bell is a certified grant-writing instructor, and in October, Nancy was honored as the first Distinguished Alumni for the Radford University College of Humanities & Behavioral Sciences in recognition of her “transformational leadership and service to others.” Currently, she is the Population Health Manager for the West Piedmont Health District.
