
"STEWARDSHIP IN THE VIRGINIA NATURAL HERITAGE PROGRAM" & "SAVE OUR STREAMS"

July 10th, 2018



Ryan Klopf will present "Stewardship in the Virginia Natural Heritage Program."
This talk will explore the history, the mission, and the scope of the Virginia Natural Heritage Program's work to protect, conserve, and restore Virginia's biodiversity.

Ryan Klopf studied at the College of William and Mary before he began working in the field of ecological restoration, first with The Nature Conservancy, and then as a graduate student at Southern Illinois University Carbondale, where he earned a Ph.D. in plant biology. In 2011, Ryan began working as a steward for the Virginia Natural Heritage Program, where he continues to work on managing and restoring natural communities within Natural Area Preserves in the Mountain Region of Virginia.



Charlotte Hubbard will present "Save our Streams."

Who keeps track of the hidden residents of local streams and waterways? These creatures reflect the health and well-being of our environment. Save Our Streams, a program of the Izaak Walton League, monitors streams and waterways locally and across the country. Still, over 80% of streams are not monitored for water quality. This talk introduces Save Our Streams and the process for monitoring the macro-invertebrates who populate our waters. who populate our waters.

Charlotte Hubbard is a certified Virginia Master Naturalist and SOS monitor. She currently monitors three stream locations in Franklin County and assists with field training for new SOS monitors.
