“WHY LLAMAS?”

June 13th, 2017




Harry Mollin will present “Why Llamas?” In this talk, we will cover the history, care, anatomy, and uses of llamas. He breeds llamas that have pretty faces, striking colors, and silky fiber. The baby llamas range from light to heavy wool and from extra large to petite while bordering on Mini. Harry selectively breeds llamas for strong Appaloosa bloodlines. As soon as possible, the baby llamas are halter and lead trained, trained to carry a pack, and many are also trained with the clicker on an obstacle course. Harry also produces working llamas, with certain llamas guarding livestock, serving as therapy llamas in hospitals, trekking with other companies, and

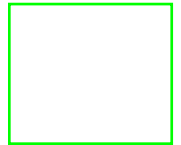
INFORMATION AT A GLANCE...
