

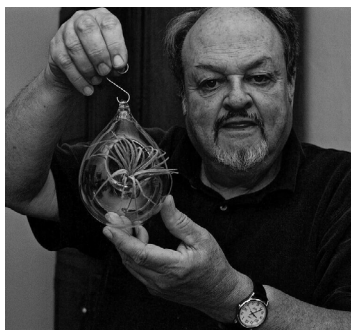

Dr. Michael Bentley will present “How Can We Bring Up Our Children in a World of Climate Change and Biodiversity Collapse?”

The planet is warming due to the burning of fossil fuels, causing our planet’s sixth major species extinction event. Public understanding through education can raise awareness on how to combat this issue. Parents and educators must be aware of the environmental perils ahead and how to help our youth develop a healthy attachment to nature. Through education, children may develop a love for nature, understand the methods under which it thrives, and learn to make environmentally conscious choices. Resources that may be used to facilitate naturalist intelligence in children will be discussed.

Michael Bentley began teaching in 1969 and has worked as a science museum educator, Governor’s School principal, and as the Virginia Department of Education’s Supervisor of Science. He was a founder of Roanoke’s Community High School. He holds degrees from King’s College, the University of Pennsylvania, and a Doctorate in Science and Environmental Education from the University of Virginia. He serves as education associate at the Virginia Museum of Natural History. Dr. Bentley has authored more than two-dozen books and chapters. Copies of his book, *Connecting Children: Ideas and Activities for Parents and Educators*, will be available for sale at the event.
