Charles Thompson, PhD. will present "Rock Castle Home."

Rock Castle Home is a documentary about people who lived in a farm community known as Rock Castle, now subsumed by the Blue Ridge Parkway. In the film, descendants from this 1930s Virginia mountain community return to their homes in seemingly pristine woodlands preserved within a national park, to show how even invisible home-places remain sacred for generations. This new documentary is now playing at PBS.org.

Charlie Thompson will present an engaging program on his recent documentary. Charles Thompson is director of the B.N. Duke Scholarship Program as well as the undergraduate program at the Center for Documentary Studies at Duke University. He holds the faculty position of Lecturer in the Department of Cultural Anthropology at Duke. Thompson holds a Ph.D. in Religion and Culture from UNC-Chapel Hill. An author and filmmaker, Thompson's works include films: Brother Towns, Rock Castle Home, and books: Spirits of Just Men, The Old German Baptist Brethren, Going Over Home, and Border Odyssey.
